**164/09. CIC ANNIVERSARY MIXED DINING IN**

In celebration of 100 years of the Cadet Instructors Cadre, the Manitoba CIC Centennial Committee has organized a Mixed Dining In Night in Winnipeg for 23 Jan 2010. Details may be found at [Annex B](#).

**165/09. CREATION OF TWO COATS MOSIDS**

1. Two new MOSIDs have been established under COATS. These are:
  - a. MOSID 00360 – General Service Officer (COATS GS-OFF); and
  - b. MOSID 00359 – General Service NCM (COATS GS-NCM).
2. These MOSIDs enable mbrs of the Supp Res, P Res or Reg F to be transferred to COATS for employment, that the CF can retain their skill sets and competencies in support of the CCO. These MOSIDs take effect 16 DEC 09. GS-OFF will encompass pers from the rank of 2Lt/ASLt to Col/Capt (N), while GS-NCM will encompass pers from the rank of Pte (T)/AB to CWO/CPO1.
3. Pers who are currently mbrs of the Supp Res and who are employed in support of the CCO shall be sub-component transferred to the applicable new MOSID. Mbrs within these MOSIDs may be promoted IAW current promotion policy for specific periods of employment. Mbrs employed on CI A or B Res svc will be paid IAW existing compensation and benefits instructions. They are not eligible to receive specialist pay regardless of their prior Reg F or Res F occupation.
4. Pers cannot enrol directly into either new MOSID without prior CF svc. Mbrs must meet the enrolment standards for the CIC in order to transfer into the COATS sub-component, must have a minimum reliability screening of Enhanced Reliability and may require a higher security clearance depending on specific job requirements. GS-OFF and GS-NCM are required to complete a Police Records Check / Vulnerable Sector Screening (PRC/VSS) and renew this every five years.
5. GS-OFF and GS-NCM mbrs shall retain the DEU, branch affiliation and accoutrements of the occupation from which they have transferred.
6. In addition, an Inactive List has been created within COATS to manage pers who are not currently serving within the sub-component, but for whom there may be a future requirement. This is a concept similar to the Supp Res.

1. The Ref was published in order to improve service times and directed mbrs to FAX claims to the Fin Svcs Section for finalization, with the hard copy following. Our experience since clearly shows that this procedure is not sustainable.
2. It is a Statutory requirement that all claims must be signed in ink by the claimant and original receipts must be included. A significant number of claims submitted by FAX since the release of the Ref were not followed by either the hard copy or original receipts, so this practice must cease.
3. Effective immediately, all claims shall be submitted as hard copies, with original signatures and original receipts. Claims that do not follow this procedure will be brought to the attention of the claimant for corrective action.

Retention of IMP and MRE by the corps often causes the meal to be rendered unfit for consumption, as they do have a defined shelf life.
2. The most effective means to support cdt trg is for the corps to return IMP and MRE so that they may be used to support another trg activity. There are sufficient stocks of IMP and MRE on hand that retention by the corps is not necessary.

**General**

1. Qualified CIC Officers are invited to apply for employment as Escort Officers for Advanced Training/Exchanges and as Staff for the Basic Parachutist Course to be conducted during the 2010 summer training period.

**Criteria**

2. Officers must meet the following criteria:

a. General - Escort Officers and Basic Parachutist Staff

- (1) qualified to the rank of Captain or be eligible to be employed as a Captain WSE;
- (2) meet the fitness requirements applicable to the exchange/course for which they seek employment (see para 6 below);
- (3) be actively involved at the LHQ level during the current training year, either on paid establishment or as a volunteer;

- (5) be medically and dentally fit;
- (6) be functional in English, bilingual preferred;
- (7) have a valid First Aid qualification; and

- (2) in normal circumstances, and on the basis of performance, must be available for employment for two years, the first year as 2IC, and the second year as OIC of the same course;

- (5) have valid first aid certification – Standard level with CPR;

The following qualifications, knowledge, skills and experience are desirable in a CIC officer who applies for the international exchange program:

- (7) bilingualism (English-French);

Physical Fitness Standards

7. The physical fitness standards which must be met by applicants are as follows:
  - a. MLE, OBW, OBS, Germany: Silver level of the Army Cadet Fitness Test;
  - b. Australia, Norway and South Korea: Bronze level of the Army Cadet Fitness Test; and
  - c. Para: 1.6 km run in 7:30; 31 consecutive sit-ups; and 7 chin-ups.
8. The ACFT/Para test results must be indicated and certified by an evaluator on the application form. The 17-18 year old scale must be used for the ACFT.

**NOTE: Officers selected for employment will be required to undergo physical fitness testing on arrival at the CSTC to confirm that the required standards of physical fitness have been maintained.**

9. Officers selected for participation shall be informed through the applicable RCSU by April 15.
